Canvass Board Meeting

The Canvassing Board of Clitherall Township held an emergency meeting on Tuesday, March 9, 2010 following the adjournment of the Annual Meeting to canvas the results of the election. An emergency meeting was required as the required three day posting of a specific date and time was not possible due to short and concurrently running time periods for duties of the Election Judges preparing a summary statement within 24 hours of the closing of the polls according to MN State Statute 204c.27 and the requirement of the Canvassing Board to canvass returns and declare results of the election within two days after the election, according to MN State Statute 205.185. An emergency existed as it was not possible to wait for the regular town board meeting scheduled for March 18, 2010 (more than two days after the returns of the Election Judges Summary Statement) or to give proper notice for a special meeting of the Canvassing Board. Because of these circumstances, in the judgment of the public body, immediate consideration by the Canvassing Board was required.

Verbal notice of an emergency meeting was given to persons present immediately upon the adjournment of the annual meeting, which was properly published and noticed. The meeting was held in the at the site of annual meeting to canvas the election results.

The meeting was called to order by Clerk Jan Eitzen at 10:10 p.m. In attendance were Lyman Trutna, Dallas Grewe, Polly Berg, Craig Bengtson, Nate Seeger, the township attorney, two other members of the pubic, and clerk, Jan Eitzen. Trutna and Grewe represented a quorum for the Canvassing Board.

The board certified the following election results.
