Planning and Zoning: Nelson reported that the city is in the final stages of drafting their Well Head Protection ordinance.

Zoning Administrator, Bengtson, issued building permit to Swedberg Nursery.

Public Comment: A resident asked about paving 380th Ave.

A resident mentioned two bad locations on 170th in the spring. Bengtson will ask Leach or Schmidt to see if something can be done yet this year. Bengtson will also check with Tordenskjold township on a culvert. The board also discussed a spot on Crane Lake Drive and 355th needs grading.
