MINUTES OF HEARING – RESOLUTION DETERMINING SUFFICIENCY  
OF PETITION FOR WESTWOOD DRIVE/HILLSIDE ESTATES AND  
APPOINTMENT OF ENGINEER

The Hearing was called to order at 6:35 P.M. by Chairman Donald Davenport. All board members present; Lyman Trutna showed up a little late. Doc Ellingson asked about blacktopping 385<sup>th</sup> Ave. There has been no petition presented to the board at this time. He was advised to present a petition, and will be forwarded information to that end.

Sharleen Schmidt, of Hillside Estates, said she's not seen the petition for blacktopping Hillside Estates, and is contesting the project, etc. She also has problems w/MnDOT and issues w/R/W and their driveway. Her issue seems a little unclear at this point. Discussion followed.

Donald Davenport asked that Engineer Stabnow study the size and shape of the cul-de-sac on Hillside Estates, when it's blacktopped, as it's a concern for a resident. A plastic culvert located on Kathy Bares' lot may need to be removed. She feels it's not necessary.

At this point, signatures on the petition were counted; 15 of 24 potential property owners signed this petition. On motion by Dallas Grewe, and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lyman Trutna, the board passed a resolution establishing the legality and sufficiency of the petition to blacktop Hillside Estates/Westwood Drive. MP/U.

Lyman Trutna made a motion to appoint Engineer Jeff Stabnow, Clitherall, MN, to function as the Township Engineer for this project. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lyman Trutna. MP/U.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:35 P.M. on a motion by Dallas Grewe, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lyman Trutna. MP/U.
